## CALL FOR PAPERS

### For the 9<sup>th</sup> Conference of MA students & PhD Candidates in Classics

Within the framework of the Postgraduate Programme in Classics, the Division of Classics and the Laboratories of Classical Philology and Ancient Greek and Latin Language and in collaboration with the Municipality of Dodoni, we are pleased to announce the **9<sup>th</sup> Conference of Postgraduate Students & PhD Candidates in Classics**.

This international conference will take place **in person** on **May 16-17, 2025**, at a venue provided by the Municipality of Dodoni (near the Ancient Theater of Dodoni).

The primary aim of the conference is to highlight the field of Classics and promote original academic research on ancient Greek and Roman culture, the two fundamental pillars of modern European civilization.

More specifically, the conference provides an opportunity for young scholars in the field of Classics to present their research findings, communicate, and exchange ideas with peers, thereby gaining recognition in their field.

**Postgraduate Students and PhD Candidates in Classics (Ancient Greek and Latin Philology)** from higher educational institutions in Greece and abroad are invited to participate.

Interested individuals are invited to send the following to the conference's email address ([9th.classics.conf.uoi@gmail.com](mailto:9th.classics.conf.uoi@gmail.com)) with the subject line "**9<sup>th</sup> Conference of MA Students & PhD Candidates in Classics**":

1. **A Certificate of Enrollment** from the university they are affiliated with.
2. **Two files** (doc or docx format) containing the abstract of their presentation:
  - One **named file** with the author's details.
  - One **anonymous file** without any identifying information.

The abstract must not exceed 400 words and should be accompanied by:

- A **list of references** (up to 15 entries).
- **Five keywords**.  
(The reference list and keywords **are not included** in the word count.)

The named file should include the following details:

- Full name of the presenter.
- Status (Postgraduate Student/PhD Candidate).
- Affiliated university.
- Personal email address.
- Contact phone number.

## Formatting Requirements

- Font: **Times New Roman** (or another Unicode font, if necessary), **12pt**.
- Line spacing: **1,5**.
- Text alignment: **Justified**.
- Title: **Centered**, in **bold**.

**Note:** Abstracts **not** adhering to **all** these guidelines will be automatically **rejected**.

## Presentation Details

- Each presentation is strictly limited to **20 minutes**, followed by a **5-10 minute** discussion.
- Presentations may be delivered in **English** or **Greek**.

## Important Dates

- **Abstract Submission Deadline:** 28/02/2025
- **Notification for results:** 30/03/2025

The abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee of the Conference, which comprises faculty members from the Department of Philology at the University of Ioannina.

Accepted presentations will be published in the proceedings of the conference after evaluation.
